

## Residential Tenancies Board


### Determination Order

**Ref: DR0116-23824**

In the matter of Sandra Clarke [Applicant Landlord] and Mark Donohue [Respondent Tenant] the Residential Tenancies Board, in accordance with section 121 of the Residential Tenancies Act 2004, determines that:

1. The Notice of Termination served on 23 November 2015 by or on behalf of the Applicant Landlord on the Respondent Tenant in respect of the tenancy of the dwelling at Apartment 310, The Old Infirmary, Johns Hill, Waterford is valid.
2. The Respondent Tenant and all persons residing in the above dwelling shall vacate and give up possession of the above dwelling within 7 days of the date of issue of the Order.
3. The Respondent Tenant shall pay the sum of €2,444.70 to the Applicant Landlord, within 28 days of the date of issue of the Order, being rent arrears in respect of the tenancy of the above dwelling.
4. The Respondent Tenant shall continue to pay any further rent outstanding from 1 April 2016, at the rate of €490.00 per month or proportional part thereof at the rate of €16.11 per day and any other charges as set out in the terms of the tenancy agreement for each month or part thereof, until such time as he vacates the above dwelling.
5. The Applicant Landlord shall refund the entire of the security deposit of €490.00 to the Respondent Tenant, on gaining vacant possession of the above dwelling, less any amounts properly withheld in accordance with the provisions of the Act.
