
Determination Order

Ref: DR1215-23075

In the matter of David Brickley [Applicant Landlord] and Christine Errity [Respondent Tenant] the Private Residential Tenancies Board, in accordance with section 121 of the Residential Tenancies Act 2004, determines that:


1. The Notice of Termination served on 15 October 2015 by the Applicant Landlord on the Respondent Tenant in respect of the tenancy of the dwelling at 15 The Rise, Melrose Park, Kinsealy, County Dublin is valid.
2. The Respondent Tenant and all persons residing in the above dwelling shall vacate and give up possession of the above dwelling within 56 days of the date of issue of this Order.
3. The Respondent Tenant shall pay the total sum of €14,165.76 to the Applicant Landlord, in 141 consecutive monthly payments of €100 on the 28th day of each month, followed by one payment of €65.76 on the 28th day of the immediately succeeding month, commencing on the 28th day of the month immediately following the date of issue of this Order, being rent arrears of €15,365.76, having deducted the entire of the justifiably retained security deposit of €1,200 in respect of the tenancy at the above dwelling.
4. The enforcement of this Order for such payment of €14,165.76 will be deferred and the total sum owing reduced by the cumulative sum paid in the monthly instalments made by the Respondent Tenant to the Applicant Landlord on each due date until such time as the total sum of €14,165.76 has been paid in full.
5. For the avoidance of doubt, any default in the payment of any of the monthly instalments shall act to cancel any further deferral and the balance due at the date of default of any such monthly payment shall immediately become due and owing to the Applicant Landlord.
