The free training is designed to:

- 1 – Make you aware of your rights and responsibilities as a landlord and the responsibilities of your tenants.
- 2 – Help you fulfil them.

What will I learn?

The free training session takes place over a full Saturday or over two evening sessions.

The content covers:

- Pre-tenancy guidance
- How to manage a tenancy throughout from beginning to end
- Rights and responsibilities – landlord and tenant
- Dispute prevention and what to do if things go wrong
- Minimum standards – how to ensure your property is compliant with the minimum standards
- How to end a tenancy – information on how to correctly serve notice and what reasons can be relied upon

Why should I attend?

The RTB recognises the invaluable role landlords have in providing homes but also that the legal framework governing the rental sector is complex and continually evolving. It can be difficult to manage tenancies and keep up to date with the policy and legislative changes in the sector.

RTB Betterlet Accredited landlords will be able to set themselves apart in the rental sector and be recognised as professionals providing a quality service while also being confident in how to apply and adhere to the regulatory framework under which they operate their business.
