In the matter of Steve McDaid [Applicant Landlord] and Czeslaw Treichel [Respondent Tenant] the Residential Tenancies Board, in accordance with section 121 of the Residential Tenancies Act 2004, determines that:

- 1. The Notice of Termination served by the Applicant Landlord on 17 January 2018 on the Respondent Tenant in respect of the tenancy of the dwelling at 66 Bantry Square, Blanchardstown, Dublin 15, D15 E300, is valid.
- The Respondent Tenant and all persons residing in the above dwelling shall vacate and give up possession of the above dwelling within 14 days of the date of issue of this Order.
- 3. The Respondent Tenant shall pay the total sum of €5,326.15 to the Applicant Landlord, within 14 days of the date of issue of this Order, being rent arrears in respect of the tenancy of the above dwelling.
- 4. The Respondent Tenant shall also pay any further rent outstanding from 04 April 2018 to the Applicant Landlord at the rate of €1,200.00 per month or proportionate part thereof at the rate of €39.45 per day unless lawfully varied, and any other charges as set out in the terms of the tenancy agreement for each month or part thereof, until such time as hevacates the above dwelling.
- 5. The Notice of Termination served by the Applicant Landlord on 20 July 2017 with respect of the tenancy of the above dwelling is invalid.
- 6. The Applicant Landlord shall refund the entire of the security deposit of €1,200.00 to the Respondent Tenant, upon the Respondent Tenant vacating and giving up vacant possession of the above dwelling, less any amounts properly withheld in accordance with the provisions of the Act.
