Determination Order

In the matter of Dorin Marcel Ioancea, Ioleana Ioancea [Applicant Tenants] and Charles Spillane [Respondent Landlord] the Residential Tenancies Board, in accordance with section 121 of the Residential Tenancies Act 2004, determines that:

- 1. The Notice of Termination served on 22 September 2017 by the Respondent Landlord on the Applicant Tenant, in respect of the tenancy of the dwelling at 63 Broadmeadow Castle, Ashbourne, Co Meath, is valid.
- 2. The Applicant Tenant and all persons residing in the above dwelling shall vacate and give up possession of the above dwelling within 14 days of the date of issue of this Order.
- 3. The Applicant Tenant shall pay the total sum of €4,833.92 to the Respondent Landlord in 11 equal consecutive instalments at the rate of €400.00 per calendar month on the 28th day of each month, followed by one further instalment of €433.92 the immediately succeeding month, commencing the next month after the issue of this Order. This sum represents rent arrears of €4,833.92 in respect of the tenancy of the above dwelling.
- 4. The Applicant Tenant shall also pay any further rent outstanding from 07 December 2017, being the date of the Adjudication Hearing, at the rate of €1,100.00 per month or proportional part thereof at the rate of €36.16 per day and any other charges as set out in the terms of the tenancy agreement for each month or part thereof, until such time as the Applicant Tenant vacates the above dwelling.
- 5. The enforcement of this Order for such payment of €4,833.92 will be deferred and the total sum owing reduced by the cumulative sum paid in the monthly instalments made by the Applicant Tenant to the Respondent Landlord on the due date.
- 6. For the avoidance of doubt any default in the payment of the monthly instalments of €400.00 shall act to cancel any further deferral and the balance due at the date of default shall immediately become due and owing to the Respondent Landlord.
- 7. The Respondent Landlord shall refund the entire of the security deposit of €1,100.00 to the Applicant Tenant, on gaining vacant possession of the above dwelling, less any amounts properly withheld in accordance with the provisions of the Act.
