

## **Residential Tenancies Board**

### **Determination Order**

**Ref: DR0219-52060**

In the matter of Respond [Applicant Landlord] and Annette Byrne [Respondent Tenant] the Residential Tenancies Board, in accordance with section 121 of the Residential Tenancies Act 2004, determines that:

1. The Notice of Termination with a service date of 5th November 2018, and served by the Applicant Landlord upon the Respondent Tenant in respect of the tenancy of the dwelling at 2 Flinters Close, Athy, Co. Kildare is valid.
2. The Respondent Tenant and all persons residing in the above dwelling shall vacate and give up possession of the above dwelling within 7 days of the date of issue of this Order.
3. The Respondent Tenant shall pay the total sum of €9,271.34 to the Applicant Landlord, in 23 equal consecutive instalments at the rate of €400 per month on the 28th day of each month, followed by one further instalment of €71.34 in the immediately succeeding month, commencing the next month after the issue of this Order. This sum represents rent arrears in respect of the above dwelling.
4. The enforcement of this Order for such payment of €9,271.34 will be deferred and the total sum owing reduced by the cumulative sum paid in the monthly instalments made by the Respondent Tenant to the Applicant Landlord on each due date until such time as the total sum of €9,271.34 has been paid in full.
5. For the avoidance of doubt, any default in the payment of any of the monthly instalments shall act to cancel any further deferral and the balance due at the date of default of any such monthly payment shall immediately become due and owing to the Applicant Landlord.
6. The Respondent Tenant shall also pay any further rent and charges outstanding from 3rd May 2019, being the date of the Adjudication hearing, at the rate of €135 per week or proportionate part thereof at the rate of €19.29 per day until such time as she vacates and gives up possession of the above dwelling.
