Determination Order

Ref: DR0220-60644

In the matter of Mary Collins [Applicant Landlord] and George Cristo [Respondent Tenant] the Residential Tenancies Board, in accordance with section 121 of the Residential Tenancies Act 2004, determines that:

1. The Notice of Termination with a date of service of 10 January 2020, served by the Applicant Landlord on the Respondent Tenant, in respect of the tenancy of the dwelling at 8 Suir House, Canada Square, Waterford, Co Waterford, X91AE28, is valid.
2. The Respondent Tenant and any other persons residing in the dwelling shall vacate and give up possession of the above dwelling within 7 days of the expiration of the emergency period as defined in section 3 of the Emergency Measures in the Public Interest (Covid -19) Act 2020 or as extended by order under section 4 of the Emergency Measures in the Public Interest (Covid -19) Act 2020, or within 7 days of the date of issue of this Determination Order, whichever is the later.
3. The Respondent Tenant shall pay the total sum of €4,250.00 to the Applicant Landlord by way of 4 consecutive instalments at the rate of €1,000.00 per calendar month, on or before the 28th day of each month, followed by one further instalment of €250.00 on or before the 28th day of the immediately succeeding month, commencing the next month after the issue of this Determination Order. This sum represents rent arrears of €4,250.00 on 21 May 2020, in respect of the tenancy of the above dwelling.
4. The Respondent Tenant shall also pay any further rent outstanding from 22 May 2020, at the rate of €850.00 per month, or proportionate part thereof at the rate of €27.95 per day, unless lawfully varied, and any other charges as provided for under the terms of the tenancy agreement for each month or part thereof, until such time as the above dwelling is vacated by the Respondent Tenant and any other persons residing therein.
5. The enforcement of this Determination Order for such payment of €4,250.00 will be deferred and the total sum owing will be reduced by the cumulative sum paid in monthly instalments, by the Respondent Tenant to the Applicant Landlord, on each due date, until such time as the total sum of €4,250.00 has been paid in full.
6. For the avoidance of doubt, any default in the payment of any of the monthly instalments shall act to cancel any further deferral and the balance due at the date of default of any such monthly payment shall immediately become due and owing to the Applicant Landlord.

7. The Applicant Landlord shall refund the entire of the security deposit of €850.00 to the Respondent Tenant, on gaining vacant possession of the above dwelling, less any amounts properly withheld in accordance with the provisions of the Act.
