Determination Order

In the matter of Farid Shaibi [Applicant Landlord] and Gerard Arnaud Zinga [Respondent Tenant] the Residential Tenancies Board, in accordance with section 121 of the Residential Tenancies Act 2004, determines that:

- 1. The Notice of Termination with a date of service of 12th of April, served by the Applicant Landlord on the Respondent Tenant, in respect of the tenancy of the dwelling at Flat 12, Phoenix Gate, 2 North Circular Road, Dublin 7 is valid.
- The Respondent Tenant and any other persons residing in the above dwelling shall vacate and give up possession of the above dwelling within 21 days of the date of issue of this Determination Order.
- 3. The Respondent Tenant shall pay the total sum of €5,767.80 to the Applicant Landlord, by way of 2 consecutive instalments at the rate of €2000.00 per calendar month, on or before the 1st day of each month, followed by one further instalment of €1,767.80 in the immediately succeeding month commencing the next month after the issue of the Determination Order. This sum represents rent arrears of €5,767.80, in respect of the tenancy of the dwelling.
- 4. The Respondent Tenant shall continue to pay any further rent outstanding to the Applicant landlord from 5th October 2023, being the date of the Adjudication Hearing, at the rate of €1,179.00 per month, or proportionate part thereof at the rate of €38.76 per day, unless lawfully varied, and any other charges as set out in the terms of the tenancy agreement, for each month or part thereof, until such time as the above dwelling is vacated by the Respondent Tenant and any other persons residing therein.
- 5. The enforcement of the Determination Order for such payment of €5,767.80 will be deferred and the total sum owing will be reduced by the cumulative sum paid, in monthly instalments, by the Respondent Tenant to the Applicant Landlord, on each due date, until such time as the total sum of €5,767.80 has been paid in full.
- 6. For the avoidance of doubt, any default in the payment of any of the monthly instalments shall act to cancel any further deferral and the balance due at the date of default of any such monthly payment shall immediately become due and owing to the Applicant Landlord.
- 7. The Applicant Landlord shall refund the security deposit of €1,179.00 to the Respondent Tenant, upon the Respondent Tenant vacating and giving up possession of the above dwelling, less any amounts properly withheld in accordance with the provisions of the Act.
