In the matter of Mark Donnolly [Applicant Landlord] and Darragh Connolly [Respondent Tenant] the Residential Tenancies Board, in accordance with section 121 of the Residential Tenancies Act 2004, determines that:

- 1. The Notice of Termination with a date of service of 10/08/2022, served by the Applicant Landlord on the Respondent Tenant, in respect of the tenancy of the dwelling at Apartment 6, St Catherines Church Apartments, Bridgefoot Street, Dublin 8, is valid.
- The Respondent Tenant and any other persons residing in the above dwelling shall vacate and give up possession of the above dwelling within 21 days of the date of issue of this Determination Order.
- 3. The Respondent Tenant shall pay the sum of €21,138.00 to the Applicant Landlord, within 21 days of the date of issue of the Determination Order, being rent arrears in respect of the tenancy of the above dwelling.
- 4. The Respondent Tenant shall continue to pay any further rent outstanding to the Applicant landlord from 5/12/2023 being the date of the Adjudication Hearing, at the rate of €913.00 per month, or proportionate part thereof at the rate of €30.02 per day, unless lawfully varied, and any other charges as set out in the terms of the tenancy agreement, for each month or part thereof, until such time as the above dwelling is vacated by the Respondent Tenant and any other persons residing therein.
- 5. The landlord is entitled to retain the security deposit of €700.00 and set it off against rent arrears.
