Determination Order

In the matter of Dermot Keogh, Orla Keogh [Applicant Landlords] and Patience Ogene, Joseph Ogene [Respondent Tenants] the Residential Tenancies Board, in accordance with section 121 of the Residential Tenancies Act 2004, determines that:

- 1. The Notice of Termination served by the Applicant Landlords on 24th April 2019 on the Respondent Tenants in respect of the tenancy of the dwelling at Apartment 22, Rosedale, Tyrconnell Street, Inchicore, Dublin 8 is valid.
- 2. The Respondent Tenants and all persons residing in the above dwelling shall vacate and give up possession of the above dwelling within 28 days of the date of issue of this Order.
- 3. The Respondent Tenants shall pay the total sum of €1,859.18 to the Applicant Landlords, in 2 equal consecutive instalments at the rate of € 900.00 per calendar month, on the 1st day of each month, followed by one further installment of €59.18 in the immediately succeeding month, commencing the next month after the issue of this Order. This sum represents rent arrears of €1,859.18 in respect of the tenancy of the above dwelling.
- 4. The enforcement of this Order for such payment of €1,859.18 will be deferred and the total sum owing reduced by the cumulative sum paid in the monthly instalments made by the Respondent Tenants to the Applicant Landlords on each due date until such time as the total sum of €1,859.18 has been paid in full.
- 5. For the avoidance of doubt, any default in the payment of any of the monthly instalments shall act to cancel any further deferral and the balance due at the date of default of any such monthly payment shall immediately become due and owing to the Applicant Landlord.
- 6. The Respondent Tenants shall also pay any further rent outstanding from 2nd August 2019, being the date of the Adjudication hearing, at the rate of €900.00 per month or proportional part thereof at the rate of €29.59 per day, unless lawfully varied, and any other charges as set out in the terms of the tenancy agreement for each month or part thereof, until such time as the Respondent Tenants vacate the above dwelling.
- 7. There is no security deposit held.
