In the matter of The Trustees of the Richard Browne Pension Fund [Applicant Landlord] and Mubarak El Mubarak [Respondent Tenant] the Residential Tenancies Board, in accordance with section 121 of the Residential Tenancies Act 2004, determines that:

- 1. The Notice of Termination with a date of service of 3 June 2022, served by the Applicant Landlord on the Respondent Tenant, in respect of the tenancy of the dwelling at 40 Manor Avenue, Maryborough Ridge, Douglas, Co. Cork, T12FX04, is valid.
- 2. The Respondent Tenant and any other persons residing in the above dwelling shall vacate and give up possession of the above dwelling within 10 days of the date of issue of this Determination Order.
- 3. The Respondent Tenant shall pay the sum of €3,690.00 to the Applicant Landlord, within 10 days of the date of issue of this Determination Order, being rent arrears in respect of the tenancy of the above dwelling.
- 4. The Respondent Tenant shall also pay any further rent outstanding from 24 November 2022, being the date of the Adjudication Hearing, at the rate of €1,450.00 per month or proportionate part thereof at the rate of €48.00 per day, unless lawfully varied, and any other charges as provided for under the terms of the tenancy agreement for each month/week or part thereof, until such time as the above dwelling is vacated by the Respondent Tenant and any other persons residing therein.
- 5. The Applicant Landlord shall refund the security deposit of €1,450.00 to the Respondent Tenant, on gaining vacant possession of the above dwelling, less any amounts properly withheld in accordance with the provisions of the Act.
