## **Determination Order**

## Ref: DR0818-46891

In the matter of Paul Doherty, Muriel Doherty [Applicant Landlords] and Edward Long [Respondent Tenant] the Residential Tenancies Board, in accordance with section 121 of the Residential Tenancies Act 2004, determines that:

- 1. The Notice of Termination for breach of tenancy obligations served on 15th June 2018 by the Applicant Landlords on the Respondent Tenant, in respect of the tenancy of the dwelling at 34 Sea Road, Arklow, Co. Wicklow is valid.
- 2. The Respondent Tenant and all persons residing in the above dwelling shall vacate and give up possession of the above dwelling within 28 days of the date of issue of this Order.
- 3. The Respondent Tenant shall pay the total sum of €8,496.59 to the Applicant Landlords, in 4 equal consecutive instalments at the rate of €2,000.00 per calendar month, on the 28th day of each month, followed by one further instalment of €496.59 in the immediately succeeding month commencing the next month after the issue of this Order. This sum represents rent arrears and arrears in respect of utilities of €8,496.59 in respect of the tenancy of the dwelling at the above address;
- 4. The enforcement of this Order for such payment of €8,496.59 will be deferred and the total sum owing reduced by the cumulative sum paid in the monthly instalments made by the Respondent Tenant to the Applicant Landlords on each due date until such time as the total sum of €8,496.59 has been paid in full.
- 5. For the avoidance of doubt, any default in the payment of any of the monthly instalments shall act to cancel any further deferral and the balance due at the date of default of any such monthly payment shall immediately become due and owing to the Applicant Landlords.
- 6. The Respondent Tenant shall also pay any further rent outstanding from 5th September 2018, being the date of the Adjudication hearing, at the rate of €630.00 per month or proportional part thereof at the rate of €20.71 per day and any other charges as set out in the terms of the tenancy agreement for each month or part thereof, until such time as the Respondent Tenant vacates the above dwelling.
- 7. The Applicant Landlords shall refund the entire of the security deposit of €735.00 to the Respondent Tenant, upon the Respondent Tenant vacating and giving up possession of the above dwelling, less any amounts properly withheld in accordance with the provisions of the Act.
