In the matter of Maura Carolan [Applicant Landlord] and Mark O'Donoghue [Respondent Tenant] the Residential Tenancies Board, in accordance with section 121 of the Residential Tenancies Act 2004, determines that:

- 1. The Notice of Termination with a date-of-service of 15th July 2021 served by the Applicant Landlord on the Respondent Tenant in respect of the tenancy of the dwelling at 4 Academy Court, Academy Street, Navan, Co. Meath, is valid.
- 2. The Respondent Tenant, and any other persons residing in the above dwelling, shall vacate and give up possession of the dwelling within 42 days of the date of issue of this Determination Order.
- 3. The Respondent Tenant shall pay the sum of €1,257.06 to the Applicant Landlord, within 42 days of the date of issue of this Determination Order, being rent arrears in respect of the tenancy of the above dwelling.
- 4. The Respondent Tenant shall also pay any further rent outstanding from 27th October 2021, being the date of the (virtual) hearing, to the Applicant Landlord, at the rate of €1,050.00 per month or proportionate part thereof at the rate of €34.52 per day, unless lawfully varied, together with any other charges provided for under the terms of the tenancy agreement, for each month or part thereof, until such time as the above dwelling is vacated by him and by any other person/s currently residing therein.
- 5. The Applicant Landlord shall refund the security deposit of €1,800.00 to the Respondent Tenant, on gaining vacant possession of the above dwelling, less any amounts properly withheld in accordance with the provisions of the Act.
