Determination Order

In the matter of Marie Rafter [Applicant Landlord] and Inara Jirgensone [Respondent Tenant] the Residential Tenancies Board, in accordance with section 121 of the Residential Tenancies Act 2004, determines that:

- 1. The Notice of Termination with a service date of 17/07/2023, and served by the Applicant Landlord upon the Respondent Tenant in respect of the tenancy of the dwelling at 4 St. Ita's Terrace, Wexford, Y35 C5D9 is valid.
- 2. The Respondent Tenant, and all other persons residing in the above dwelling, shall vacate and give up possession of that dwelling within 14 days of the date of issue of the Determination Order.
- 3. The Respondent Tenant shall pay the total sum of €2922.00 to the Applicant Landlord, in 11 equal consecutive monthly instalments at the rate of €250.00 per month, on the 28th day of each month, followed by one further instalment of €172.00 in the immediately succeeding month, commencing the next month after the issue of the Determination Order. This sum represents rent arrears in respect of the tenancy of the above dwelling.
- 4. The enforcement of the Determination Order for such payment of €2922.00 will be deferred and the total sum owing reduced by the cumulative sum paid in the monthly instalments made by the Respondent Tenant to the Applicant Landlord on each due date until such time as the total sum of €2922.00 has been paid in full.
- 5. For the avoidance of doubt, any default in the payment of any of the monthly instalments shall act to cancel any further deferral and the balance due at the date of default of any such monthly payment shall immediately become due and owing to the Applicant Landlord.
- 6. The Respondent Tenant shall continue to pay rent as it falls due, from 19/04/2024 in the sum of €950.00 per month or proportionate part thereof, for as long as she continues to reside in the above dwelling.
