## **Determination Order**

Ref: DR1018-48983

In the matter of Fergal O'Connor [Applicant Landlord] and Elhadi Ibrahim, Aseela Ibrahim [Respondent Tenants] the Residential Tenancies Board, in accordance with section 121 of the Residential Tenancies Act 2004, determines that:

- 1. The Notice of Termination served on 13 August 2018 by the Applicant Landlord on the Respondent Tenants in respect of the tenancy of the dwelling at 14 Fernwood Crescent, Wilton, Co. Cork is valid, and the tenancy of the Dwelling terminated on 11 September 2018.
- 2. The Respondent Tenants and all persons residing in the above dwelling shall give up possession and vacate the dwelling in which they are in unlawful occupation and overholding, and return the keys of the Dwelling to the Applicant Landlord or his agents, within 70 days of the issue of this Determination Order.
- 3. The Respondent Tenants shall pay the Applicant Landlord the total sum of €500.00 within 70 days of the date of issue of the order. This sum represents rent arrears up to 8 January 2019 in respect of the tenancy of the above dwelling of €739.00 less the amount of €239.00 in respect of damages for breach of landlord obligations to carry out repairs at the Dwelling up to 8 January 2019.
- 4. From 9 January 2019 onwards (day after the hearing) the Respondent Tenants shall also pay the equivalent of the rent at the rate of €1,207.50 per months or €39.70 per day unless lawfully varied, and any other charges set out in the terms of the tenancy agreement, until such time as they vacate the dwelling.
- 5. The Applicant Landlord shall refund the entire of security deposit of €1,050.00 to the Respondent Tenants on gaining vacant possession of the above dwelling, less any amounts properly withheld in accordance with the provisions of the Act.
