Determination Order

In the matter of Eamonn Galavan [Applicant Landlord] and Jelena Palmova [Respondent Tenant] the Residential Tenancies Board, in accordance with section 121 of the Residential Tenancies Act 2004, determines that:

- 1. The Notice of Termination served on the 21st August 2018, by the Applicant Landlord on the Respondent Tenant, in respect of the tenancy of the dwelling at 10 Belleville, New Ross, Co. Wexford, is valid.
- 2. The Respondent Tenant, and any other person/s residing in the above dwelling, shall vacate and give up possession of the dwelling within 14 days of the date of issue of this Order.
- 3. The Respondent Tenant shall pay the total sum of €3,271.26 to the Applicant Landlord, by way of 8 consecutive monthly payments of €400.00, to be paid on or before the 28th day of each month, followed by one further payment of €71.26, to be paid on or before the 28th day of the 9th month, payment commencing on the 28th day of the month immediately following the month of issue of this Order. This sum of €3,271.26 being rent arrears in respect of the tenancy of the above dwelling.
- 4. The enforcement of this Order for such payment of €3,271.26 will be deferred and the total sum owing will be reduced by the cumulative sum paid in the monthly instalments by the Respondent Tenant to the Applicant Landlord, on each due date, until such time as the total sum of €3,271.26 has been paid in full.
- 5. For the avoidance of doubt, any default in the payment of any monthly instalment shall act to cancel any further deferral and the balance due at the date of default of any such monthly payment shall immediately become due and owing to the Applicant Landlord.
- 6. The Respondent Tenant shall also pay any further rent outstanding from the 28th November 2018, being the date of the Adjudication hearing, to the Applicant Landlord, at the rate of €750.00 per month or proportionate part thereof at the rate of €24.66 per day, unless lawfully varied, together with any other charges provided for under the terms of the tenancy agreement, for each month or part thereof, until such time as the above dwelling is vacated by the Respondent Tenant and all persons residing therein.
- 7. The Applicant Landlord shall refund the entire of the security deposit of €750.00 to the Respondent Tenant, upon the Respondent Tenant vacating and giving up possession of the above dwelling, less any amounts properly withheld in accordance with the provisions of the Act.
