In the matter of IRES Properties REIT Plc [Applicant Landlord] and Ciara Bermingham [Respondent Tenant] the Residential Tenancies Board, in accordance with section 121 of the Residential Tenancies Act 2004, determines that:

- The Notice of Termination with a date of service of 12 September 2022 served by the Applicant Landlord on the Respondent Tenant, in respect of the tenancy of the dwelling at Apartment 111, Charlestown Place, Saint Margaret's Road, Dublin 11, D11W9Y8, is valid.
- 2. The Respondent Tenant and any other persons residing in the above dwelling shall vacate and give up possession of the above dwelling within 10 days of the date of issue of this Determination Order.
- 3. The Respondent Tenant shall pay the sum of €3,742.11 to the Applicant Landlord, within 10 days of the date of issue of this Determination Order, being rent arrears in respect of the tenancy of the above dwelling.
- 4. The Respondent Tenant shall also pay any further rent outstanding from 28 February 2023, being the date of the Adjudication Hearing, at the rate of €1,733.00 per month or proportionate part thereof at the rate of €56.97 per day, unless lawfully varied, and any other charges as provided for under the terms of the tenancy agreement for each month/week or part thereof, until such time as the above dwelling is vacated by the Respondent Tenant and any other persons residing therein.
- 5. The Applicant Landlord shall refund the security deposit of €3,398.72 to the Respondent Tenant, upon the Respondent Tenant vacating and giving up possession of the above dwelling, less any amounts properly withheld in accordance with the provisions of the Act.
