In the matter of Paul McGrath [Appellant Tenant] and Tuath Housing Association Clg [Respondent Landlord] the Residential Tenancies Board, in accordance with section 121 of the Residential Tenancies Act 2004, determines that:

- 1. The Appellant Tenant is in breach of the provisions of 16(h) of the Act by behaving in a way that was anti-social within the meaning section 17(1)(b) of the Act, in respect of the tenancy of the dwelling at 15 Mount Eagle Square, Sandyford, Dublin 18.
- 2. The notice of termination served by the Respondent Landlord on the Appellant Tenant on 27 June 2023 is valid.
- 3. The Appellant Tenant and all other persons residing therein shall vacate and give up possession of the above dwelling within 28 days of the date of this Determination Order.
- 4. The Appellant Tenant shall continue to pay rent in respect of the tenancy of the above dwelling at the rate of €55.99 per week, unless lawfully varied, until such time as he vacates the dwelling.
